



PE and Sports Premium Funding at Kew Woods Primary School

Swimming Curriculum



About the PE and sport premium funding:

- Schools receive PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in years 1 to 6 (or pupils aged five to 10 if they don't follow year groups).
- Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of the PE and sport they offer. For swimming and water safety this includes: provide additional swimming provision targeted to pupils not able to meet the swimming requirements of the national curriculum

From 2017 schools have been required to publish how many Year 6 pupils have met the national curriculum requirements relating to swimming and water safety.

National Curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety:

swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
use a range of strokes effectively
perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
